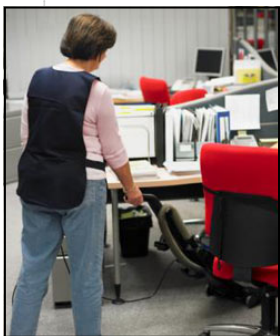
Langports Job Help
